### **COUNTABLE NOUNS**

a tree

We can count

Have a singular and plural form Can use a *singular* verb or

The **book** *is* old.

The books are old.

### **UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS**

a plural verb

We cannot count

Have only one form (no plural)

→ butter

butters

two trees

Always use a singular verb

Sugar <u>is</u> sweet.

a bread

two rice

Cannot use *a*, *an* or *a number* before them

wood, glass, paper, gold, silver, ice, iron, cotton, wool, steel


